Positive Behavior Supports involves direct support to classroom teachers for implementing strategies in their classrooms that target those students who need additional behavioral programming. Effective and efficient classroom-based interventions will be presented. The focus will be on realistic interventions in general education classrooms.

WHO: Dr. Melody Tankersley, Kent State University

Melody Tankersley, PhD, is a professor of special education at Kent State University. Prior to beginning her graduate studies, Dr. Tankersley taught students with emotional and behavioral disorders, a population of students who continue to be the focus of her instructional and scholarly endeavors. Dr. Tankersley focuses her work on issues related to positive behavioral practices, the prevention of emotional and behavioral disorders, parent interventions, and bringing research to bear upon practice. She has published more than 60 professional journal articles, chapters, and texts and addressed more than 100 national and international audiences.
