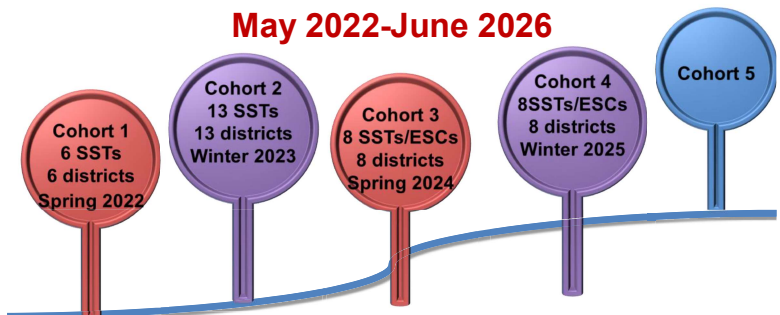

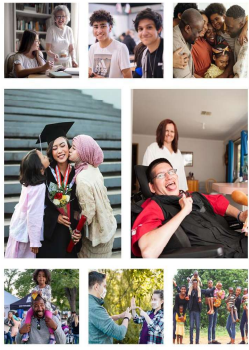


Career Advising Policy
